2012 KICKIN’ IT UP IN THE HILLS CLASSIC
TOURNAMENT INVITATION**



Hello, Coaches!

Region 779 is proud to invite you to attend the 18th Annual AYSO Invitational Kickin’ It Up In The Hills Classic Tournament

Scope: AYSO Invitational – open to AYSO teams only from all Sections.

When: **March 30th, 31st April 1st , 2012** (Rain-Out Dates June 3rd, 4th, 5th)
 Friday: March 30 6:00 – 10:00 p.m. (local teams) Tournament pool play
 Saturday: March 31st 8:00 a.m. – 10:00 p.m. Tournament pool play
 Sunday: April 1st 8:00 a.m. – 6:00 p.m. Pool play & Finals

Where: *City of Chino Hills (local parks and schools) **There is no charge for parking. No pets are allowed at fields.***

Who: AYSO boys and girls teams in age divisions: U-19, U-16 (11v11) 18 players max. U-14 (11v11) 15 players max. U-12 (9v9) 12 players max. and U-10 (7v7) 10 players max. All players must be registered and have played in the AYSO 2011 primary season. Guest players will be allowed (3 maximum per team). Co-ed teams will be accepted in boys’ divisions only. Laminated AYSO Player Ids are required.

What: This year we will attempt to create multiple flights based on each teams record in the U10 & U12 divisions. Our intent will be to balance flights to insure play is balanced for all teams (Based on applications received). Play will consist of a minimum of three scheduled games in a round-robin “pool play” format. All pool games will be as follows: (70 min. for U-19, 70 min. U-16, 60 min. for U-14, 50 min for U-12, and 40 min for U-10)

The top teams will advance to the medal round on Sunday afternoon..

Why: The disposition of net profits from the 2012 Tournament will be used to help fund our AYSO Spring Program and to cover spring expenses (Fields, Lights etc..) and to help reimburse our teams with a portion of their spring tournaments and area fees.

Awards: Each player and coach receive a T-Shirt & a tournament pin. **Sportsmanship medals will be awarded to all U10 players that do not finish 1st – 4th.** Medals will be awarded to 1st, 2nd, 3rd & 4th place teams in each flight. Note in flights with only 4 teams, medals will only be awarded to 1st & 2nd place teams.

Refunds:	\$425.00 PER TEAM* (U-12 only)	<u>Must accompany the application</u>
	\$450.00 PER TEAM* (U-14)	<u>Must accompany the application</u>
	\$475.00 PER TEAM* (U-16 thru U-19)	<u>Must accompany the application</u>

A full refund will be issued if tournament is canceled and cannot be rescheduled. If a team withdraws 30 or more days before the tournament, a full refund is given. Within 30 days of the tournament, no refund is provided unless a replacement team is found.

Referee Fee, Refunds: \$200.00 PER TEAM* – Each Referee Team shall expect to officiate at least 3 games to qualify for refund. Three games minimum to guarantee deposit refund (no partial refunds). Referee refunds will be sent within 14 days of the tournament.

Rules: A full set of tournament rules are posted on the tournament website.

Acceptance: To be accepted, all teams must submit application form, team roster, T-Shirt Form and an AYSO region check. All team roster forms must be approved by the Regional Commissioner. Once a team is accepted coaches will receive a packet containing the tournament information and Rules. Game and referee schedules will be communicated about a week before the tournament starts, by email, website or surface mail. All AYSO teams must follow the uniform requirements set by AYSO National. The application deadline is February 29th. All teams will be notified within 48 hrs of the application deadline or receipt of application (whichever is latest) as to their status. Teams that are not accepted will be given the option to have their complete application returned within 48 hours or to be placed on the waiting list.

How: Team entry applications and all necessary forms are available on the tournament website. Please send 1 Region check that covers both the Entry and Referee fees, along with the tournament application, referee information form, T-Shirt Order Form and team roster to the Tournament Registrar address below. Regional commissioner must sign application and team roster. Appropriate referee administrator must sign referee information form. See referee form for details.
